Date: Saturday, February 27th, 2016 - 3 p.m. - 6 p.m. - Winners will be announced at 7:00 p.m. during the after party at Superior Sands Bar & Grill (located in the Mall near Yonkers). Live music provided by Kicking Rocks. It's beach party! Flip flops, Hawaiian shirts and lawn chairs are encouraged.

Location: Mariner Retail Business Center (Mariner Mall), 69 North 28th Street, Superior, WI 54880

Setup Time: Saturday, February 26th, 1:00 p.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Tear-Down Time: 6:00 - 6:30 p.m. Contestants must have everything out of the mall no later than 6:30 p.m.

Prizes

Prizes will be awarded in both the professional and amateur divisions and in all three categories:

- 1st Place - \$100
- 2nd Place - \$75 Super One Gift Card
- 3rd Place - \$50 Super One Gift Card

Prize payouts may be subject to change based on the level of participation. If it becomes necessary to modify the prize payouts the committee's decision is final.

Professional Division

Any business or organization that regularly serves food as a part of their normal business operations. \$50 entry fee. Professionals are encouraged to promote their business with signage, literature, coupons, etc.

Amateur Division

The entry fee for any individual, business or organization that does not serve food as a part of their operations is \$25. Amateurs may promote a business, organization, cause, event, etc. in their serving area by paying an additional \$25 promotion fee. Organizations with 501(c)3 status may promote themselves and are exempt from paying the additional \$25 promotion fee. All other amateur entries are not allowed to promote anything at their booth.

Contestants may enter in one or more of the following four categories:

1. Entrees (main dish)
2. Soups, Stews, Chowders (**Excluding Chili** - The United Way already hosts a Chili Cook-Off, please enter your chili in their event).
3. Other (appetizers, desserts, dips, drinks, etc...)

Contestants are responsible for providing:

- A minimum of 8 quarts of their Crockpot creation for each category entered
- A complete list of all ingredients written on a 3" x 5" recipe card for each entry (so those who have food allergies can avoid potential problems)
- Extension cord
- Serving utensils

Organizers will provide:

- Table (2.5' x 6') & Chair (additional tables may be rented for \$10 and chairs are available for \$2)
- Rubber gloves for serving
- Plastic spoons
- Sample cups
- Napkins
- A limited number of extension cords will be available

"What a Crock!" - Contestant Agreement

The "What a Crock! Crockpot Cook-off for Cancer Care" contestant agreement (herein "agreement") is made as the date set forth above, by and between the Keyport Krew Dragon Boat Team and

_____ (herein, "Exhibitor").

Article 1. Premises

The Keyport Krew is authorized to use the main hallway of the Mariner Retail Business Center for the "What A Crock! Crockpot Cook-Off for Cancer Care." The Keyport Krew agrees to provide space on the premises to the contestant. The contestant will be assigned booth(s), the location(s) of which will assigned at the time you check in at the event. Each booth space shall be one banquet table and one chair.

Article 2. Term

The term of this agreement shall begin on February 27th, 2016 at the Exhibitor's set up time as assigned in Article 5 and ending on February 27th, 2016 at 6:00 p.m.

Article 3. Entry Fee

Contestant shall pay the amount of \$50 if entering as a professional or \$25 if entering as an amateur and an additional \$25 (excluding non-profit organizations) if an amateur would like to display any promotional materials for a business or organization.

Article 4. Liability

The Keyport Krew Dragon Boat Team shall not be liable in damages or otherwise for the interruption or impairment or the furnishing of any supplies or services. Keyport Krew Dragon Boat Team shall not be liable in damages. Contestants shall be solely responsible for any and all defects in its entry.

Article 5. Conduct of Exhibitor

Use of Premises. Contestants shall not use the premises for any unlawful purpose, and will comply with all rules and policies of the City of Superior and all present and future laws, ordinances, regulations and orders of all government units having jurisdiction over the premises.

- A. Contestant agrees they shall set up its booth on February 27th, 2016 between 1:00 p.m. and 2:30 p.m. and be ready for operation at 3:00 p.m.
- B. Contestant agrees their table shall not be taken down until 6:00 p.m. on February 27th.
- C. Contestant agrees to have everything packed up and out of the mall before 6:30 p.m. on February 27th.
- D. Contestant agrees they shall contain its business and merchandise to its assigned booth space. The Keyport Krew Dragon Boat Team reserves the right to charge exhibitor for additional square footage used by the exhibitor.

Article 6. Cancellation

The contestant will be entitled to no refund of their payment for cancellation of participation. If the event must be cancelled for any reason outside of the Keyport Krew Dragon Boat Team's control, the Keyport Krew Dragon Boat Team reserves the right to retain all amounts paid by the contestant.

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
